finally have the details. The association WILL NOT meet at Collin Creek Church in Plano. Due to circumstances outside their control, they have graciously asked to not host the meeting. The association WILL meet on June 11-12, 2025, at Lakehills Free Will Baptist Church (https://www.lakehillsfreewillbaptist.com/) in Cedar Park, Texas (1580 Cypress Creek Road, Cedar Park, TX 78613). We are grateful to Pastor Wes Hood and the church at Lakehills for hosting the meeting on short notice.





The theme for the 2025 Meeting is "Reimagining Church" and our keynote speaker is Eric Thomsen. Eric is the Managing Editor of ONE Magazine (https://onemag.org/), as well as a gifted speaker, writer, and Free Will Baptist historian. We will take a scriptural and historical look at what the church is and is not, how we came to where we are, and where do we go from here. Make plans now to be there!

We can also announce that we have a block of rooms available at the Home2 Suites by Hilton Austin/Cedar Park, TX, 14022 US Highway 183 Austin, Texas 78717. This hotel is located about 2.5 miles from the host church. The room rate is \$92 per night for a queen room, \$99 per night



for a king room, and \$115 for a queen/queen room. All rooms are suites and in-
